Christmas Open House and Nativity Scenes from Around the World: All are welcome to come to the parish rectory in Koeltztown for an open house and to see over 50 nativity scenes from around the world. Fr. Greg has collected nativity scenes for many years: some wood, clay, pottery, papier mache, grass/plant fiber, metal; some from Europe, the Holy Land, Africa, South America, Central America, North America; some carved, cast, woven; some brightly colored and some simple and natural. 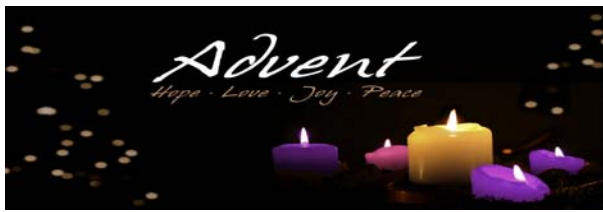
