Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

I had heart surgery in May. I was fortunate to be under the care of wonderful medical professionals. I was so grateful to have countless people praying for me. I could feel the mercy of God pouring over me. I mention this in light of the theme for our Diocesan Mission Collection: "To announce the mercy of God, the beating heart of the Gospel." As Pope Francis explains it, mission carries mercy to the far corners of the world -- reaching the poor, the sick, the forgotten and the dispossessed. Many of them do not have access to basic health care, much less skilled surgeons. Many of them have never known the grace of a faith community that cares for them. Our work of mercy provides meals to hundreds of hungry kids and elderly. It starts schools in India and supports medical care for the poor in Peru and the Philippines. God's mercy is spiritual as well as material. People need to belong to a community, need to be able to worship, work, and walk with each other. This is why we continue to support parishes in Peru and help start new ones in India and the Philippines. Anyone who has experienced the mercy of God wants to share this life-giving gift. We have a chance to do that this week in the Diocesan Mission Collection. Be a part of the "beating heart of the Gospel."
