PSR: We are excited to share with you some great news! The Parish School of Religion (**PSR**) catechists are geared up for another year of teaching and sharing the Catholic faith. We invite all public-school children of the parish, grades Kindergarten thru 5th grade, to join us this catechetical year as we dive into a wonderful program called "Be My Disciples". Please join us **Wednesday, August 23 at 6:30 p.m.** in the parish gym for a short orientation of our program. You will have an opportunity to preview our program, meet our teachers and locate classrooms. Our goal is to instruct the children in our parish family as a community of believers in the Catholic faith. Biweekly (twice a month) instructions include faith-enriching experiences such as liturgies, faith instructions, prayer, sacramental preparation, and discussions leading to moral awareness. Parents as primary educators are involved at all levels. Our parish provides this PSR program to help parents fulfill their obligations as primary educators of our Catholic Faith. The cooperation between parents and teachers will result in responsible behavior essential for the growth of the student as a contributing member of the Catholic community. 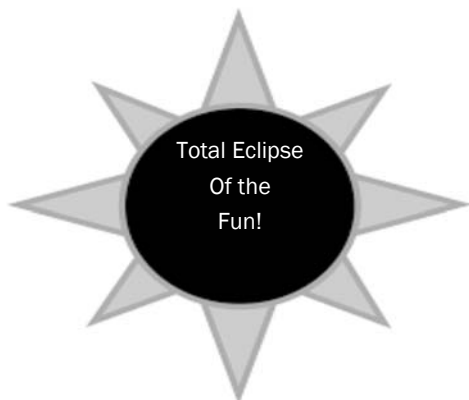
