St. Stanislaus School News

March

During March several important activities occur: registering for the next school year, creating new school calendar; budget work and offering contracts. In addition the School Advisory Board will be preparing a five year Plan of Action based on the recommendations of the Visiting Team of the Self-Study Process.

This year, our returning school families re-enroll on line in our Option C program. Families new to our school will need to contact the school for the registration process. 636-7802.

It is also time to enroll in the Early Childhood Program.

A child in the St. Stanislaus School Early Childhood Program will engage in a number of learning experiences that foster cognitive, physical, social emotional and spiritual development. The program uses the *Happily Ever After* pre-literacy program which focuses on oral language, listening, following directions and fine motor skills. This program is continued in kindergarten as the Super Kids reading program.

A child must be 4 by Aug. 1 to enroll. There are 19 seats available. The Registration Fee is \$200, to hold a seat. The program fee is \$450 a month for ten months or \$4500 for the total school year. There is Before and After School Care available for an additional fee. Lunch is \$50 a month or children can bring their own lunch. The class usually fills up before the end of May and we begin a waiting list.
