The attendance for our Hour of Power, Wednesday evening (Parish School of Religion & Offering Myself to God) youth nights hosted an average of 125 youth. Forty high school juniors received the Sacrament of Confirmation and 13 people were brought into the church through our RCIA (adults)/RCIC (children) program. We hosted Sunday evenings faith and fun events for middle school / high school youth with attendance close to 100. In addition, the adults of our community were offered Bible and church history studies, small group faith-sharing opportunities, Catholic benedictions/devotions and adoration.

Thoughts from our catechists;

*"The students consistently teach me that they are open to doing God's work, and they really desire to learn more about their faith. Their excitement about finding specific verses in the Bible or learning new prayers is so contagious! I absolutely love each class when they share how they have been a light to the world since our last class. Sometimes when one of the students can't think of something they did, another student will chime in and say something like, "Remember, you helped Johnny pick up his books when he fell in the hall." Their excitement fuels my faith."*

*"I learned about my own faith. Basics such as the order of the mass followed a logical progression which spoke a natural truth. I could see they were genuinely understanding this new faith and that made me feel they were ready for their new life-in-Christ."*

*"Teaching the faith has become a wonderful opportunity to review what I was taught as a child. It draws me into my faith. Preparing lessons helps me think outside of myself and I try to think about where the students are in their ability to learn about Jesus and the Church. Just like Jesus, I'm trying to meet them where they are at. This has helped me in my daily interactions with others as well."*

*"The challenge to live according to Christ's laws and teachings is real. As our children turn into young adults, we must be here to help guide and remind them who Christ wants us to be. I can't help but think of all the wonderful role-models in my youth. I want to be that for someone else."*

Thank you to all within our community who volunteer in the many facets of Church life. We simply would not be strong without you.

Today, the Church celebrates Ascension Sunday. Jesus' last command before His Ascension is known as *The Great Commission* where He directed us to "go and make disciples". May we all reflect and respond in accordance with His teaching and continue to spread the Good News.
