Greetings from school: September is another full month of learning activities. Thursday the DARE officers in training came to our school to get some classroom experience. This is a great opportunity for children and officers to build relationships in the classroom and on the playground. On Friday we had a visit from Three Rivers Electric who did a demonstration on safety and electricity for our students. The students in grades 6, 7, and 8 had a wonderful service opportunity on Friday. They walked to Blair Oaks and provided service during the Special Olympics event. The school's first Spirit Day is Friday, Sept. 28. Once a month students are allowed to show their school spirit by wearing a tee shirt that identifies their school or parish by name. The first week of October will find our students, Grades 3-8, taking Iowa Basic Skills test. These tests are a good measure of student skills, teacher instruction, and strength of our current curriculum.
