Saturday, July 15, 2017

Everyone is asked to help clean up the grounds starting at 8:30 a.m. Stands to be erected **NO LATER THAN NOON** so the electrical committee can install proper lighting. No electrical lighting installed on Sunday.

Sunday, July 16, 2017 and Monday, July 17, 2017

All stands must be taken down Sunday night. Help is also needed on Monday morning starting at 7:30 a.m. to clean up the grounds and put away remaining supplies.

Each family is asked to bring the following food items:

- 1 bag of potatoes - Please bring **potatoes** to the cafeteria on Saturday morning or by 7:00 a.m. on Sunday
- 1 loaf of homemade bread
- 3 large homemade pies, cobblers, or cupcakes: **Coolers will be available for cream pies**

Clean up: Workers on the last shift are asked to clean and put away all items that were used in their work area. Chairpersons are responsible to make sure this is accomplished.

Country Store Everyone is asked to bring items for the Country Store. Please bring them to the **location of the Country Store** with the name of the item(s) marked. All items should be wrapped with clear plastic material for sale.
