Bishop McKnight's Prayer Intention for September

For children deprived of a safe and healthy home, that they experience the love of God through the care and concern shown by Catholics.

Sunday Masses:

- All the faithful of the Diocese of Jefferson City, and those who are present in the territory of the Diocese, are dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays / Holy Days of Obligation until 11 September 2020, provided that for days of precept after 1 July 2020 they do one of the following:
- a. Participate in the Sunday /holy day of obligation Mass livestreamed from their parish church/ chapel, the Cathedral, or the Vatican or Heart of the Nation website.
- b. Prayerfully read and meditate on the readings of the Mass for the Sunday / holy day of obligation, and recite the Rosarv or Divine Mercy chaplet.
- Families are to maintain six-foot distancing between their family and other families or individuals throughout the celebration of Mass.
- There will be no collection of envelopes and no offertory procession, however there will be a basket in the
 front of Church and also in the back of Church for you
 to put your donation in. Thank you for your continued

Relief parents, St. Nicholas Academy: St. Nicholas Academy is a supportive living experience for boys from families that are under-resourced who want to give their sons every opportunity to succeed in school and life. St. Nick's partners with families and St. Peter Interparish School to provide this opportunity. St. Nick's is seeking Christian, married couples or single individuals who are willing to be part of a pool of relief parents. The role of relief parents is to care for the boys and home when the full-time house parents are off duty or away. Typically, the full-time house parents are off duty every fourth weekend from 9:00 AM Friday through 7:00 PM Sunday. Relief parents, on a rotational schedule, fill in during this time. They may also be asked to be on a call list to help fill in when the house parents are on vacation and/or sick. Relief parents receive an hourly wage, all legally mandated benefits and a compensation package that includes a private suite and all meals for the days on duty. 
